PRIVATE PAY DISCOUNT POLICY

We give the discounts outlined below to patients who do not have insurance, **IF THE PATIENT PAYS IN FULL AT THE TIME OF SERVICE.**

Sick Visits - 20% discount, on all services, **except vaccines**. Consultation visits are considered "sick visits". For example, visits for Attention Deficit Disorder, Eating Disorders, etc.

Well Visits - 40% discount, on all services, **except vaccines**.

Well & Sick Visits - 40% discount, on all services, **except vaccines**.

Deductibles, Health Savings Accounts, Medical Savings Accounts, and Health Reimbursement Accounts: If a patient has a deductible to meet, a health savings account, medical savings account, or a health reimbursement account, they are eligible for the discounts listed above, **except vaccines***, if they pay in full at time of service.

Vaccines from our regular stock - 20% discount on the vaccine.

Vaccines from our "Vaccines for Children" – VFC Stock The government provides our office with vaccines for under insured and non-insured patients. If your child qualifies for the VFC program, we charge for administering the vaccine. Occasionally some vaccines are not available through the VFC program. In this case, parents may purchase the vaccine from our regular stock.

Who is eligible for Vaccines For Children – VFC Stock

- √ Patients without insurance or insurance that does not cover vaccines.
- √ Patients with limited coverage for vaccines. The patient is eligible once they have reached or exceeded their insurance coverage limit. For example, the patient has coverage up to \$100 for vaccines. We will use our regular stock for the first \$100 of vaccines. After the \$100 limit is met, we will use VFC stock.
- √ Patients, who have coverage for certain vaccines, but not all vaccines. The patient can receive the VFC vaccine if it is not covered by their insurance.

Who is NOT eligible for Vaccines For Children – VFC Stock

- √ * Patients with **Deductibles, Health Savings Accounts, Medical Savings Accounts, and Health Reimbursement Accounts** are **NOT** eligible for VFC vaccines. The patient is considered "fully insured" and cannot receive VFC vaccines. The parent will be responsible for paying for the vaccine from our regular stock until the deductible is met.
